2. We continue to need all persons receiving service to wear a mask  not only in our building but in the community as mandated by PHO.

3. With wellness checks in mind- **if you are ill we encourage you to remain home.** If you are presenting with a fever  **we will require you to go home, call 811  and follow that information provided.** We will ask that you keep us informed about the next steps you are taking.
4. **Hand Washing** and sanitizing will be requested and required .
5. Visits with DSPs working at   will be limited to a **2-hour maximum that is planned and scheduled.** While in the building masks will be worn , cleaning and sanitizing after use will be expected  .
6. Transportation  will remain based on **essential, purposeful, and unique needs.** We will continue to encourage individuals to look how to plan how they will meet their transportation needs.
7. We will continue to look at **possible compliant** community locations for inclusive activities and plan accordingly.
